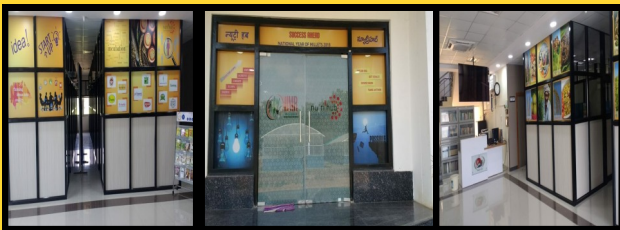
Technology Business Incubator (Nutrihub)
