Training-cum-learning "Awareness programme on plant variety protection"

Training-cum-learning "Awareness programme on plant variety protection" was organized by DSR Hyderabad on 30 March, 2011, to create awareness on IPR issues in agriculture and plant variety protection. This event also stimulated interaction

Dr. JV Patil, Director, DSR chaired the inaugural session. The participants were trained on issues relating to plant variety protection legal issues affecting seed industry. They studied the process of filling the PVP forms and discussed intricacies involved. Drs. Vilas A Tonapi and M Elangovan were the course directors.

Field Days Organized in Rice-fallows

Dr. JV Patil, Director, Directorate of Sorghum Research (DSR) and team of scientists visited to several farmers' fields between 11 -12 March, 2011 in rice-fallows in Repalle and Nallapadu village in

Guntur district of Andhra Pradesh. Dr. Patil interacted with the farmers and discussed about the production and management practices being followed. The sorghum trials have been organized

with six public (CSH 16, CSH 23 and CSH 25) and private sorghum hybrids. National hybrids CSH 16 and CSH 25 were performing better than the locally popular private sector hybrid Mahalaxmi. After the field visits, group meetings with farmers were also organized. The meetings were chaired by Dr. JV Patil, Director, DSR and attended by around 250 farmers of this area besides Managing Director of Devgan Company, Hyderabad and ex- Sarpanch of Nallapadu village. Dr. Patil addressed the farmers about importance of sorghum and mainly as the use of sorghum fodder and its nutritional values for their animals. He advised farmers to adopt improved cultivars to get more profit. He assured them of DSR's support for sorghum development in rice-fallows by providing promising technologies and introduction of mechanization where ever possible. DSR scientists Drs. JS Mishra, B Subbarayudu and RR Chapke also participated in this event. Dr. B Subba Rayudu, explained the farmers about the benefits of sorghum cultivation in the regional language, Telugu. This programme was widely covered in the print media.

AGM 11 planned at Dharwad

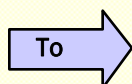
