Brain Storming Session on leveraging sorghum

Brain Storming Session on "Leveraging Sorghum for Food,



Fodder, Nutrition and Livelihood Security in the 21st century and beyond" was organized by IIMR-Hyderabad on 26 March, 2016 under the Chairmanship of Dr. JS Sandhu, Deputy Director General (Crop Sciences) – ICAR, New Delhi. This interaction was held to review and assess the contentious issues related priorities and focus areas for Sorghum Research to evolve strategies to break the yield barriers and to enhance income to farmers. This event also stimulated interaction between public and private sector scientists. Dr. Vilas A Tonapi presented the overview of sorghum research. Dr. Sujay Rakshit, Principal Scientist, presented "Long-term gains in AICSIP –Progress and a way head". Dr. V Ravindra babu, Director, IIRR, Hyderabad Dr. RK Mathur, Director, IIOPR, Pedavegi and Dr. KS Varaprasad, Director, IIOR,

Hyderabad also graced the occasion. The session was attended by ten panel experts namely, Dr. N Seetharama, former Director, IIMR; Dr. BV Subba Reddy, Ex-Principal Scientist, ICRISAT, Dr. Vincent Vadez, Asst. Research Programme Director, ICRISAT, Dr. A Ashok Kumar, Sr. Scientist, ICRISAT, Dr. S Desai, Principal Scientist, CRIDA, Dr. R Prakash, Principal Scientist, PDP, Dr. Y Yogeshwar Rao, Vikky's Agro tech, Dr. C Ramakrishna, Vice-President, Nuziveedu Seeds, Mr. Gowrishankar, Venkateswara Hatcheries, besides all scientists of IIMR. The participants discussed in detail on priorities and strategies.

He also stressed on the need to expand sorghum to non-traditional areas in eastern India and north east. This programme was coordinated by Drs. HS Talwar, Sujay Rakshit and C Aruna.

Press conference at IIMR

The press conference was addressed by Dr. Trilochan Mohapatra, Secretary- DARE and Director General, ICAR at



6 p.m. on 26 March, 2016 at IIMR, Hyderabad. The press and media from the Hindu, Business line, ETV, HMTV, Andhra Jyothy and others were present. During the meet, Dr. Mohapatra told that Indian Council of Agriculture Research continues to support Indian farmers and agribusinesses in the light of increasing resources demand for food and fuel to meet standards of food quality and safety. He said the institutes under ICAR are working to provide climate resilient varieties, hybrids and appropriate farming technologies to enhance crop productivity and income to farmers from Agriculture. He lauded the scientists for their work in improving the livelihood of dryland farmers through development of new varieties and hybrids. Regarding Bt technology he opined that India is not dependent only on MNC's, and ICAR and NARES have their own technologies that will support the farming community and seed and agriculture based industries through its cutting edge-technologies across ICAR institutions and SAUs.

He also explained that cluster of food research and commercialization facilities at ICAR institutes allows the production and promotion of healthy products that address growing health concerns. ICAR also provides training, services, and tools designed to support and enable the rural economy, stabilize and enhance farm income.

The IIMR's Institute Technology Management Committee meeting was held on 15th March 2016 at 02.30 PM with the



approval of the Chairman of ITMC. Dr Vilas A Tonapi, Director and Chairman ITMC-IIMR chaired the proceedings. The meeting was attended by the following members : Dr SK Soam, Principal Scientist – IPR Expert, NAARM; Dr IK Das, Principal Scientist and Member Secretary-IRC; Dr HS Talwar, Principal Scientist and Nodal Officer, PME Cell; Dr B Dayakar Rao, Principal Scientist; Dr KBRS Visarada, Principal Scientist, Dr CV Ratnavathi, Principal Scientist; Sri SK Singh, SAO, IIMR; and Sri AN Murthy FAO, IIMR. The meeting was organized by Dr M Elangovan, Member Secretary and Nodal Officer (IPR). The issues discussed were renting-out the roti making machine, MoU with Sneha Industries, progress of ABI, sharing of licensing fee of "Jowar Puffs" technology, request of Mrs. Razia Begam – Nizamabad, on concession of licensing fee, editor-publisher agreement between Elsevier and IIMR, innovation disclosure by IIMR scientists viz., Drs CV Ratnavathi, KBRS Visarada, B Dayakar Rao, nomination of IPR expert from IIMR as member of the ITMC, revolving fund for food products, and registration fees of under Society for Millets Research.

Monitoring of DUS Testing trials at IIMR

The monitoring of sorghum DUS Testing trials was conducted at IIMR, Hyderabad on 12 February 2016. Dr. Vilas A Tonapi, Director, IIMR monitored the trials in the presence of Dr. Hariprasanna K, Nodal Officer, and Dr. Aruna C, Co-nodal officer. Dr. Hariprasanna explained the DUS testing for different candidate varieties taken up along with the claimed distinct characteristics and the expression of the same. Under 2nd year testing three candidate varieties (CSV 26, CSV 29R and DGJ 025) were tested along with four reference varieties, and under 1st year testing four Farmers' varieties (Bagdal Peeli Jawar, Mogal Goal Jawar, Barsi Jawar and Kodamurka Jola) were tested along with M 35-1 as reference variety. The overall crop growth and expression of morphological characters was very good in all the candidate and reference varieties. The Director appreciated the overall conduct of DUS testing trials. It was suggested that the panicle shape in CSV 29R, CSV 26 and DGJ 025, where some differences were observed from the claim, and will be recorded at the time of harvest as may be observed in majority of the plants. Apart from DUS testing trials maintenance breeding of 116 reference varieties including parental lines was also taken up. The report of the monitoring team and DUS test proformae for the candidate varieties were prepared by the team.

Monitoring of DUS Testing trials at MPKV Rahuri

The DUS testing trials conducted at MPKV, Rahuri, the Co-nodal centre was monitored on 4 February 2016 by Dr. Hariprasanna K. Drs. Vijay Shelar and R. S. Shaikh, MPKV, Rahuri coordinated the monitoring. The crop had already

claimed DUS traits in candidate varieties were similar at both the locations. The committee noted the differences in observations at Rahuri and prepared the report.

46th Sorghum AGM at Udaipur

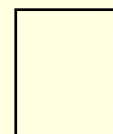
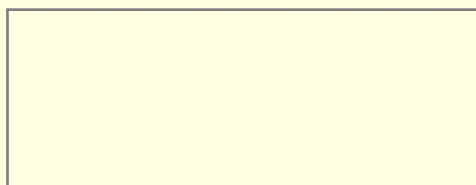
