ABOUT MILLETS

Millets are primarily categorized as major millets, including sorghum, pearl millet and finger millet, and minor millets, including foxtail, kodo, barnyard, proso, browntop, and little millet. They are currently cultivated in 131 countries across the globe over an area of 74 million ha. More than 59 crore people in Asia and Africa depend on millets as a staple food. In 2018, millets were rebranded as "Nutri Cereals" by the Government of India, recognizing their nutritional potential, and dispensing the earlier nomenclature of "coarse cereals". This led to a renewed interest globally and the United Nations General Assembly announced 2023 as the International Year of Millets, recognizing their benefits towards achieving sustainable development goals.






ABOUT HYDERABAD

Hyderabad, also known as the Pearl City, is the capital of Telangana, a state in south India. A booming technology hub in the country, it's home to many heritage sites ,restaurants and is famous for its twinkling pearls and glass bangles. As of 2011, the population of the city is 6.9 million.

Its historic sites include Golconda Fort, a former diamond-trading center that was once the capital of Qutub Shahi dynasty. The Charminar, a 16th-century mosque whose 4 arches support towering minarets, is an old city landmark near the long-standing Laad Bazaar. It is situated on the Deccan Plateau at a height of 1788 feet above sea level.

During November, the weather is pleasant with warmer days and cooler nights. The city is a centre for local traditions in art, literature, architecture, and diverse cuisines. It has several museums, bazaars, galleries, and other cultural institutions - Laad Bazaar, Madina Circle, Begum Bazaar are known since Nizams and Qutub Shahis. Salar Jung Museum, Nizam Museum, and Telangana State Archaeology Museums are notable notable attraction to experience. Hyderabadi Biryani and Haleem are distinctive cuisines of the city known to world for their authentic taste.


