

Training programme covered aspects such as Millets' production, protection, processing, value-addition, storage, soil testing etc. Farmers were taken on a guided tour of Millets Gene bank to show millets germplasm diversity, centre of excellence, primary & secondary processing facilities. Apart from this, they were made aware of suitable varieties for Andhra Pradesh, Formation of farmer producer organizations and information related to their benefits is an important part of the training. The training was organized by the Chief Course Director Dr. C Tara Satyavathi, course director Dr. A Srinivas, Senior Scientist, course co-directors -Dr Anuradha Narala, Senior Scientist and Dr. Sevanayak, Senior Scientist. IIMR Seed Distribution to Tribal farmers of Girisiri Tribal FPO

Girisiri Tribal FPO, promoted by ICAR-IIMR, Hyderabad, distributed millet seeds to farmers in Chintada village on 5th July 2025. ICAR-IIMR, Hyderabad took this initiative to support tribal farmers by providing quality seeds and thereby



to boost millet cultivation among tribal communities. The distribution focused on promoting sustainable agriculture, enhancing nutrition through millets, and improving the livelihoods of small and marginal farmers. Dr. Sangappa & Dr. Rafi, Business Expert, FPO Projects guided farmers on best practices of millet cultivation for ensuring effective use of

the seeds. This effort was anticipated to yield long-term benefits by increasing productivity and creating market opportunities for millets and millet value added products. The event was coordinated by Dr. Sangappa, Scientist & Principal Investigator, FPO Project ICAR-IIMR, and Hyderabad.

Improved Millet Seeds to Karnataka FPOs

ICAR-IIMR, Hyderabad facilitated the distribution of free millet seeds to farmers in Karnataka through its FPOs on 6th July 2025. Bettada Basaveshwara FPO, Mudhol FPO, and Shorapur Taluka Millets FPO in Karnataka distributed 1800 Kgs of seed to farmers in 3 blocks. This seed distribution is a part of ICAR-IIMR's ongoing efforts to enhance millet cultivation and support small and marginal farmers. The distribution aimed to promote sustainable farming practices, spread awareness, increase millet consumption, and strengthen the livelihoods of farming communities. By providing high-quality seeds and technical support, ICAR-IIMR assisted farmers in adopting millet-based agriculture



from the existing commercial crops. Dr. Sangappa, PI FPO Project and FPO-NEST team of ICAR-IIMR, Hyderabad facilitated this seed distribution program.

Strengthening millet entrepreneurship: Building synergies between FPOs and Startups

ICAR-IIMR, Hyderabad and Nutrihub organized Entrepreneurship Foundation Program in Millets during 14 to 17th July 2025. As a part of this program, Dr. Sangappa and Dr. Rafi from FPO NEST team delivered an insightful session on "Linking FPOs to Startups" on 16th July 2025. promoting millet FPOs across four states. Dr. Rafi briefed the millet FPO details and strategies taken by them for strengthening millet value chain. The business plans

Further the practical ways to collaborate with millet FPOs for sourcing raw materials, developing value added millet products, and establishing strong market linkages was shared with entrepreneurs. The session empowered participants with valuable strategies to build sustainable businesses by teaming up with FPOs and leveraging shared resources and networks.

ICAR-IIMR, Hyderabad organized three-day training-cumexposure visit to 12 officials of Udyogini NGO, Madhya Pradesh from 16th to 18th July 2025.
